Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking College Students with a record of volunteerism in the community.
- * Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.0, and plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.
- * Applicants must be FOP Lodge 94 members, County of Will Employees or Children/Grandchildren of the

Employee.

- * Scholarship funds will be paid *in December 2023 or January 2024 for the second semester of the student* directly to the college and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Foundation at that time an invoice for second semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.
- * Applicants must have documentation supporting their 75 hours of Community Service for 2022/2023 on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program. Application deadline is **September 11, 2023** by **4:00 p.m.** Late applications are not accepted.
